

BOARD CERTIFIED BEHAVIOR ANALYST

DESCRIPTION

Provides and supervises the provision of applied behavior analysis services to persons with IDD who exhibit challenging behavior. Duties include functional behavior assessments, development, implementation, and evaluation of behavior interventions; monitoring effects of assessments and behavior interventions; consultation to schools, families and programs; and staff/family training. Demonstrates proficiency in utilizing Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) skills, e.g., shaping, prompting, fading, chaining, errorless learning with groups of consumers. Documents data based progress and family contacts as necessary, transports consumers as necessary. This position may require flexible hours and travel to community providers/consumers' homes for training purposes.

REQUIREMENTS

MA/MS degree in Behavior Analysis from an accredited university, or MA/MS in psychology with coursework as required by the Behavior Analyst Certification Board. Certified by the Behavior Analysis Certification Board. Must maintain a valid a Texas Driver's license and safe driving record with proof of insurance.
