### **Minimum Qualifications**

Bachelor's degree in the behavioral sciences field of study from an accredited college or university. Minimum two years related work experience with behavioral health services. Requires basic computer navigation skills. Must have valid Texas Drivers' license and be insurable driver.

Prefer Master's Degree with an LCSW, LMFT or an LPC. One or more years of previous management experience preferred. Work related experience with adult mental health and children's mental health preferred.

### **Job Description**

Under the direction of the Director of Behavioral Health Intensive Services, this position is responsible for the daily clinical/administrative operations of the Center's Crisis Services program. Provides leadership, direction, and oversight of crisis intervention/response services provided across the Center's two county catchment areas by the Mobile Crisis Outreach Team (MCOT) and School & Law Enforcement Crisis Team (SLECT). Coordinates the provision of crisis response within the community to schools, homes, emergency rooms, and other community sites in response to calls from the Center crisis hotline. Responsible for coordination of the Center's on-call After Hours Response Team (AHRT) and a supervisor on-call rotation
