The Programmer Analyst will be responsible for the successful implementation of a new primary care health record software (eClinicalWorks) and will support ongoing implementation and routine production and use. The position will organize meetings, working closely with representation from various departments and subject matter experts (SMEs) to ensure the application meets the needs of the organization.

The Programmer Analyst will be responsible for supporting the implementation of a patient portal. The position will ensure accurate and seamless transmission of necessary data elements and help ensure that the portal is easy to use for staff and individuals/families in services.

Qualifications

Minimum Qualifications: The Programmer Analyst will have a bachelor's degree in social services, healthcare, information technology, or related fields. The Programmer Analyst must also have good communication skills, both orally and written, to deliver information to other staff members clearly.

- Two+ years of experience working for a medical provider or primary care organization.
- Three+ years of experience with coding knowledge in TSQL and C#
- Two+ years of experience with system-wide software implementation and managing electronic health record systems.
