Description

Assist and evaluating services of individuals in a community mental health center across northeast Texas. The Center serves individuals with Mental Health, Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities and Substance Use. The QM Specialist will work under the general supervision of the QM Manager with a moderate degree of latitude for initiative and independent judgement. Duties & responsibilities include, but are not limited to conducting program satisfaction surveys and mystery calls, center-wide Safety Officer/Safety Committee Chair; assist with contract monitoring; providing support for quality, regulatory and compliance activities for the agency to ensure services provided are in accordance with all applicable standards, rules and regulations; maintains current knowledge of rules and standards; committee involvement as needed; perform other duties and responsibilities as required, assigned or requested.

Requirements:

Some statewide travel, occasionally overnight and use of a personal vehicle for agency business will be required.

Proficient skills in the use of data and word processing equipment and software, must have a current Texas driver's license and maintain an acceptable driving record and insurability, ability to write clears, concise reports, maintain a positive working relationship with all service providers and effective time management and organizational skills.
