



## Deputy Chief Financial Officer

The Deputy CFO works closely with the CFO to execute the financial vision and strategy. They align priorities, ensuring the Deputy CFO's initiatives support the CFO's broader objectives. As Deputy CFO, you will gain exposure to board meetings, investor relations, and strategic negotiations under the CFO's guidance while being responsible for operational performance and team leadership. In this role you will support the CFO by delivering reliable results and flagging potential risks or opportunities. Direct operational responsibilities will be dependent on the Deputy CFO's past experience, demonstrated success in the joining-up process, and execution of assigned projects/tasks. Intended future responsibilities include treasury and reporting functions; revenue cycle management; oversight and supervision of the Controller and Financial Analysis and Planning positions; and serving as the CFO for the organization's Federally Qualified Health Center Look Alike operations.
