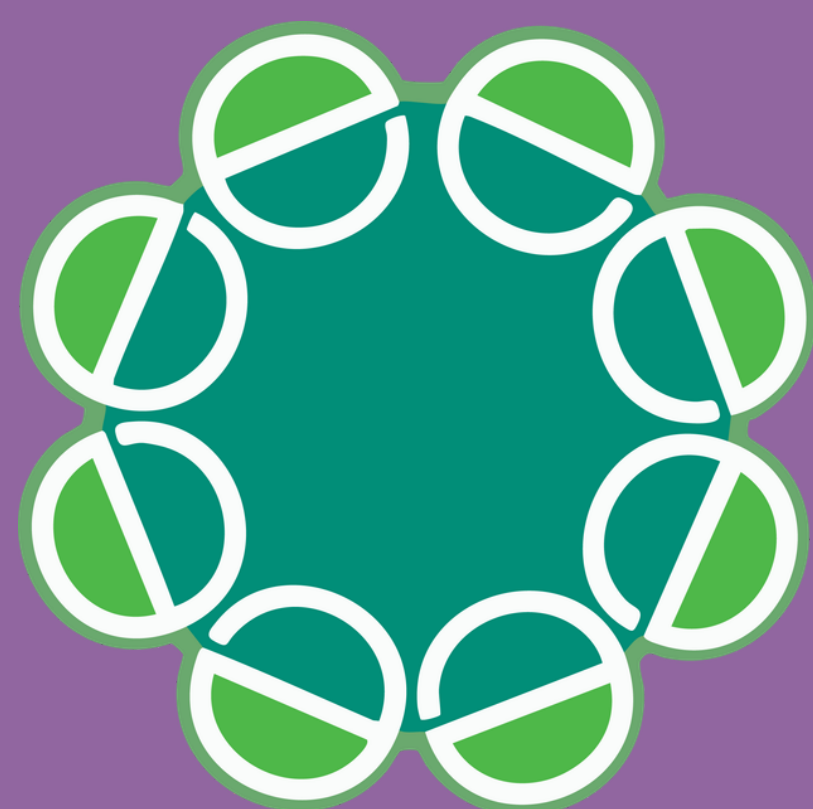
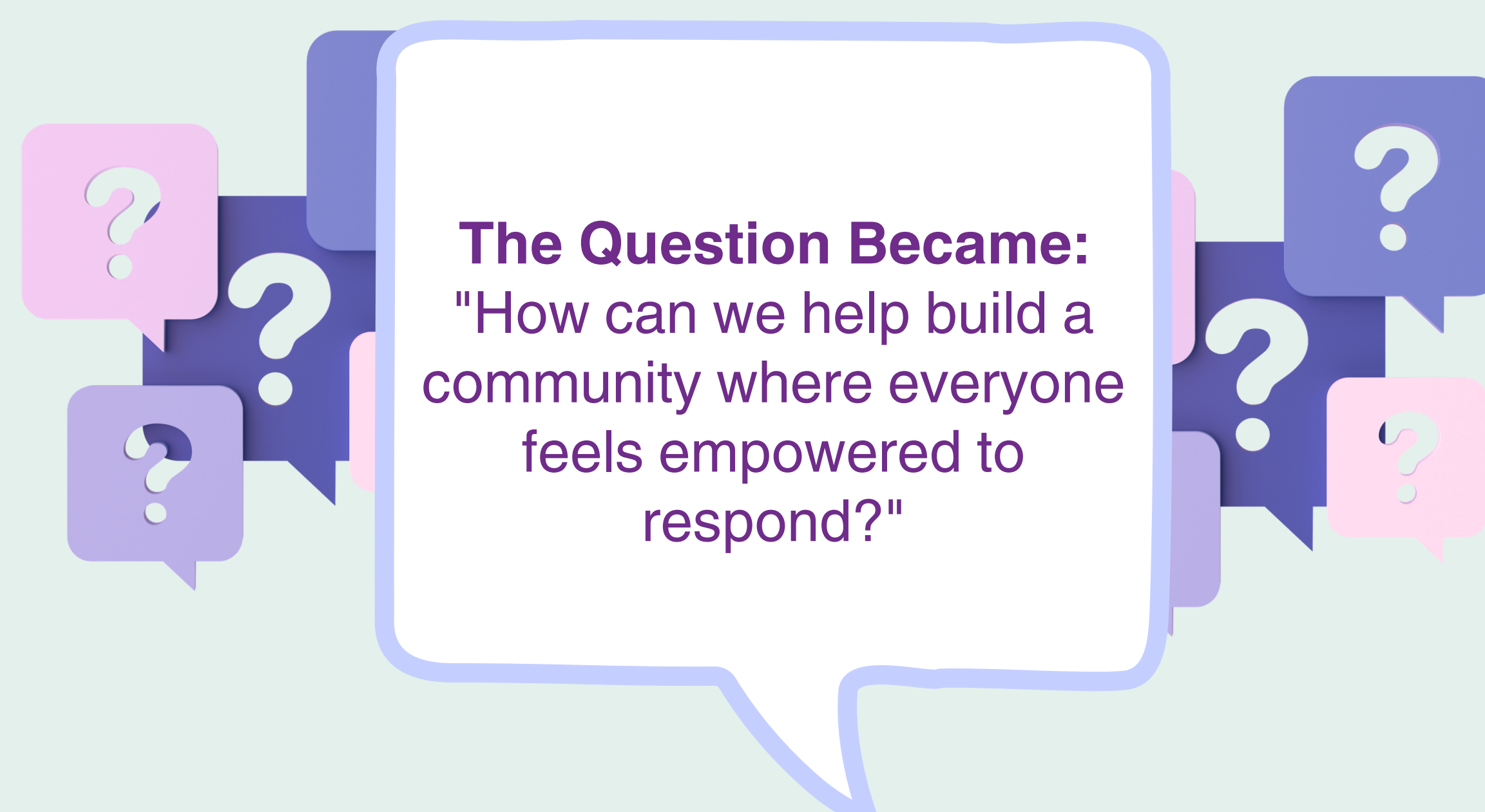
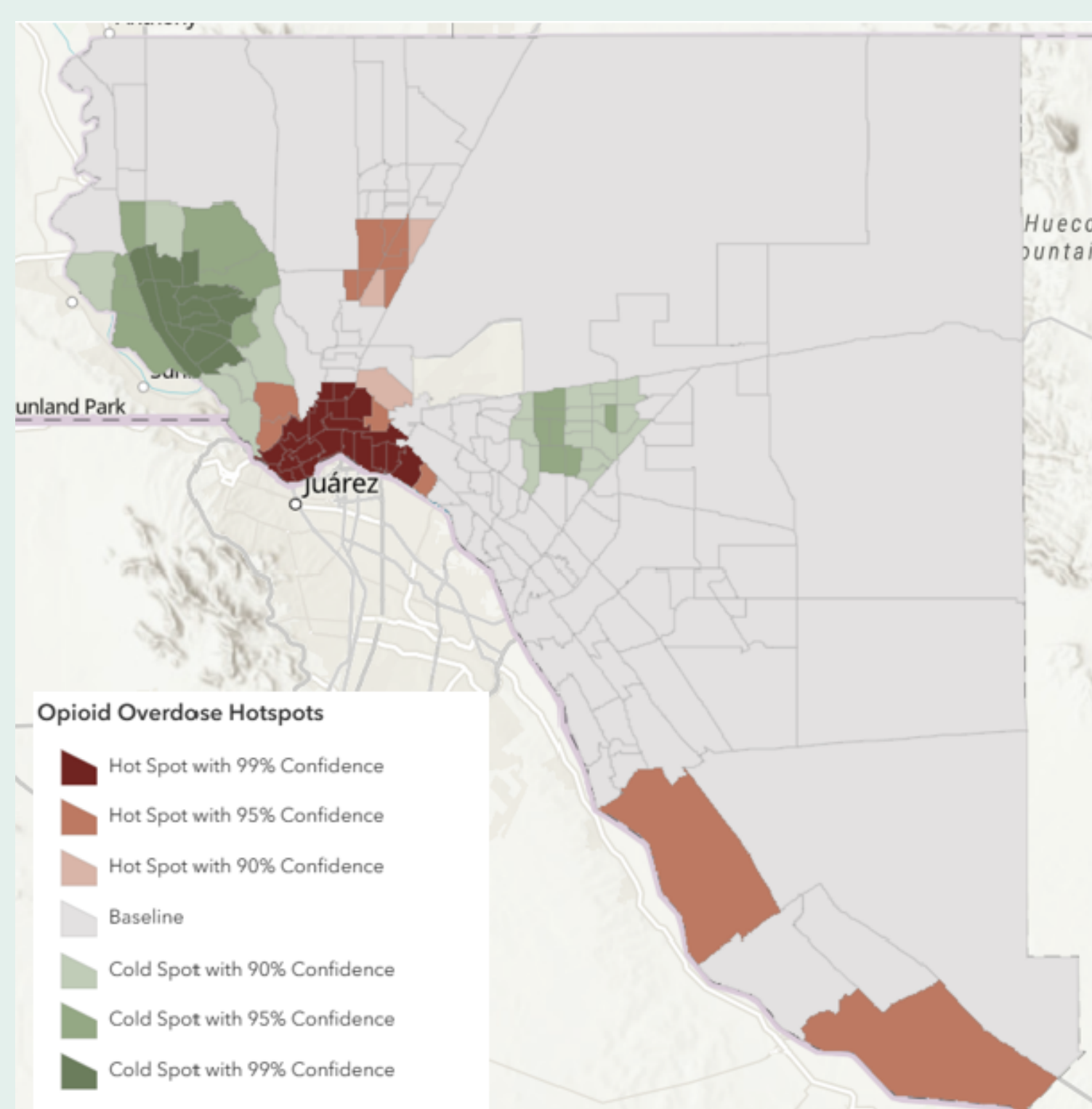

Many overdose prevention initiatives focus on professional responders. While first responders play a critical role, overdose prevention often begins long before 911 is called.

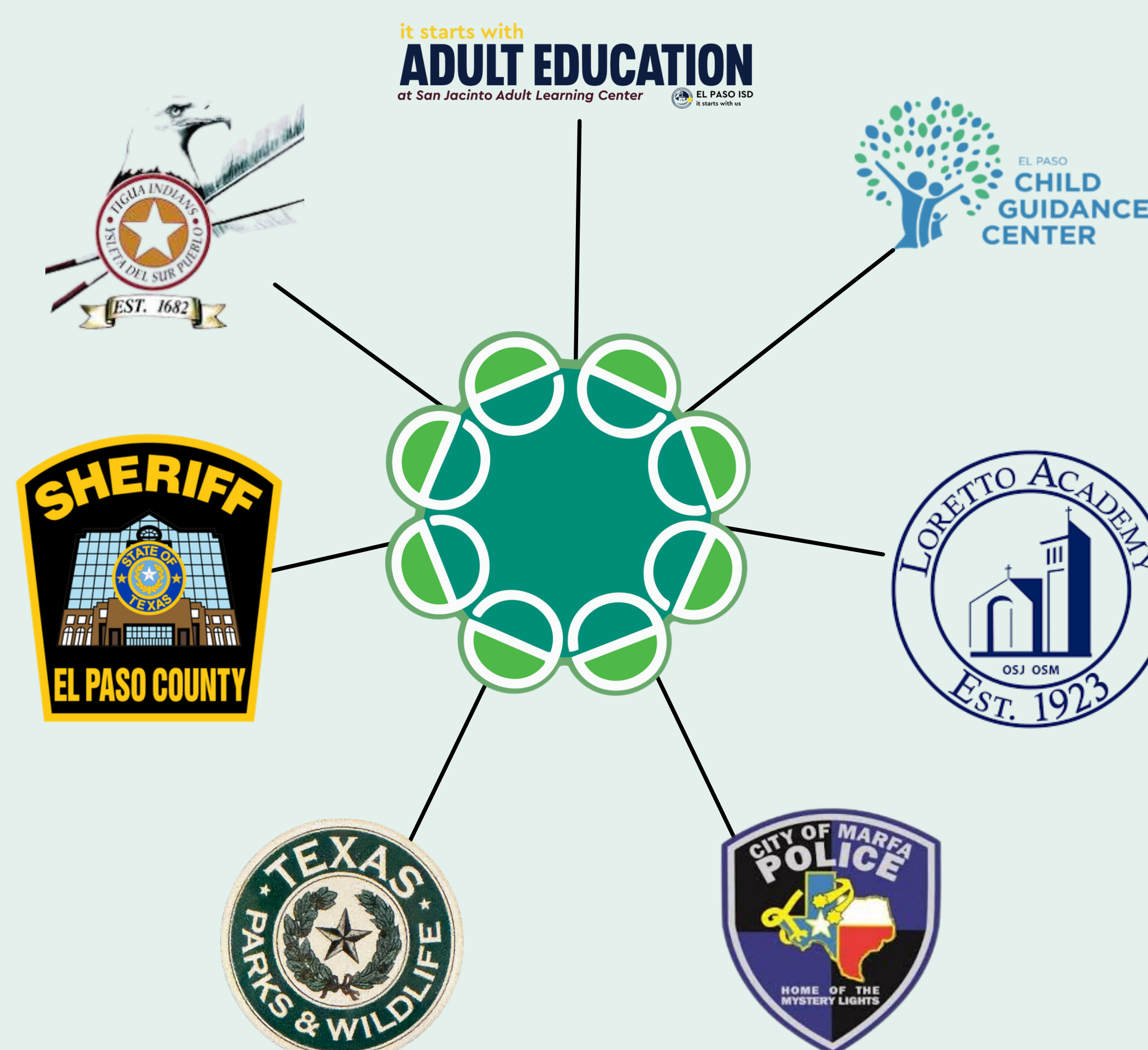


OUR APPROACH

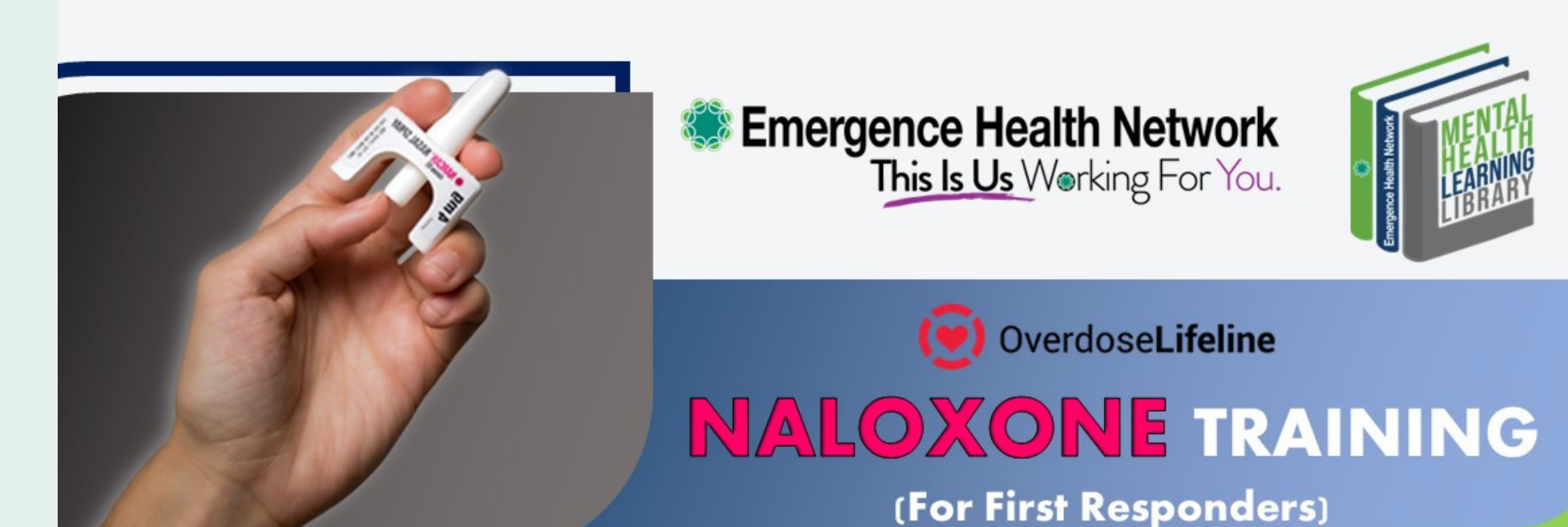
Rather than leading with a predetermined agenda, we approached community partnerships with a simple question:
